

## Scottish Youth Theatre National Ensemble 2018

### Technical Stage Manager

Scottish Youth Theatre is seeking Technical Stage Manager with experience in mixing live sound to provide technical and stage management support for SYT's National Ensemble's small scale tour in July 2018.

The National Ensemble is a group of 18 exceptional young theatre makers from across Scotland aged 16 – 25. The group works together throughout the year on monthly development weekends and then gathers in the summer for an intensive rehearsal period to create an innovative piece of theatre in collaboration with a theatre director and creative team. This year's theme will focus on mental wellbeing and mental health.

The Technical Stage Manager will:

- Liaise with and support the creative team
- Work with the Production Manager to implement the technical and stage management requirements of the touring production including all transportation of set, costumes and props
- Compile and operate prompt copy
- Basic prop making, sourcing costume and props from SYT stores and wider sourcing if required
- Manage the smooth running of rehearsals and performances, the daily set up and maintenance of scenery, furniture, costume and props
- Create and maintain a Prompt Copy of the show throughout the rehearsal process
- Ensure compliance with health and safety during rehearsals, production and performances including completion of risk assessments
- Participate in the smooth running of all get-ins and get-outs, rehearsals and performances at all venues and arrange for returns to be completed within 7 days of final performance
- Attend all production meetings and undertake all reasonable activities relating to the role of a Technical Stage Manager
